General:

Scott is rocking a 60s vibe this evening, with a purple shirt featuring pale pink and grey-blue circles under his trademark rainbow coloured tank top. Richard Ayoade and Dennis the Menace on badges.

He proceeds to mention some famous faces who've sadly passed away during the week: Dave Greenfield (The Stranglers), Florian Schneider (Kraftwerk) and Little Richard. Scott plans to pay tribute to all three in the aftershow.

Someone mentioned the signal wasn't great in the campervan. Scott explains it's nice to go into a different space after a show, which is why he likes the campervan. Plus, it's hot in his upstairs room...32 degrees, he says.

Doonicans' live shows tend to have around 120-150 capacity to retain enough intimacy for audiences to get the comic aspect, and for the band to hear their reactions. So the fact that numbers have dropped from 1000 in the first week of BNI to around 250 (previous week) doesn't bother him as it's still a larger crowd than he'd normally play for...albeit a virtual one.

A few shout outs follow.

Scott has "a nice bottle of red" for tonight.

Quizmaster 'Brian Blessed' is revealed to be Stuart Sweetchunks' dad.

Scott says the community spirit of people coming together online during these times has been one positive thing about the pandemic.

Trevor Power asks: "What was the biggest solo gig?" Scott thinks technically it might have been BNI #1 (1000 people). Or possibly Farmer Phil's festival in 2017, where he performed in front of 300-400.

Glances at watch, then: "Shit, I'm gonna have to go. Right, ok, I'll see you all in 3 minutes. Bye!"

Scott's now drinking beer after his earlier wine. Amanda's on the gin.

He hunts for a pick on the floor.

Emma Kelly asks Scott how many different instruments can the Doonicans play. He doesn't know exactly, but says he can play guitar, bass, mandolin, bouzouki and five string banjo.

On ukulele, Scott pays tribute to the late Dave Greenfield, playing The Stranglers' hit, Golden Brown.

Next up, a dedication to Florian Schneider (Kraftwerk), who also passed away this week. The whole image of the Doonicans' The Tarn Machine album was inspired by Kraftwerk. Scott plays She's From Dodworth, a Doonicans' parody of Kraftwerk's The Model.

Lin Hulme is mentioned as hosting watch parties on YouTube.

Now, Scott gives a nod to Little Richard, another famous face who departed our world this week, in the form of Long Tall Sally.

One more song is played (Madness, It Must Be Love), then Scott sits next to Amanda to thank fans for watching the show.

Scott says he's felt weird it just being Scott Doonican for a few weeks so he's tried to include footage of the band where he can, although he fears this will run out shortly.

Amanda asks viewers to send photos in of what they've been up to, to help people feel less isolated and continue the community spirit.

Scott questions if people want puppets. Amanda says they do.

Scott's brother Matthew sent him a video link of Kermit the Frog sat in a swamp on his own singing Rainbow Connection and it made him tear up. Kermit was essentially self-isolated in the swamp and Scott resonated with this due to the coronavirus situation. The clip inspired Scott and Amanda's Rainbow Connection cover. They produced the video this week. Doonifans haven't seen it yet. Scott says he'll post it in the morning.

This aftershow ends somewhat abruptly while Scott and Amanda are midway through reminding viewers to send photos in.
