The penultimate song of this Halloween special is The Time Warp from the Rocky Horror Picture Show. Scott tries to pull off some of the song's actions while still playing his guitar and singing. A jump to the left and a step to the right, if you will.

Anne Harris is announced as the 'Golden Ticket winner (she's the Shit Raffle winner really, only Scott can't say 'raffle' because of Facebook rules).

Amanda is yawning up a storm as Scott chit chats. It is quite late : )

Final song of the night (much to Amanda's delight as she can now go to bed) is Tenacious D's Tribute.

Then, a serious note: Glasses are raised to Amanda's mum who passed away this time last year, and to Doonifan Lawrence Chitty, who passed away a month ago.

They sign off with a glass clunk, a cheers and smiles all round.
