Bit of a boomer on the turntable this evening (Queens Of The Stone Age).

Scott sings along as the pre-show opens and fans arrive.

He’s sporting a rainbow tank top with pastel lilac shirt underneath. Three badges are pinned to the right hand side: A F*ck Boris one, Alan smoking a pipe, and another one saying I love Cheese.

Scott drove through Wombwell earlier and saw what he describes as “The last days of Sodom and Gomorrah”. Pubs are back open and peeps were out in force frequenting them.

With coronavirus in mind, Scott still thinks it’s too soon for so much mingling, says: “Clearly our local miscreants have not got a chuffin’ clue.”

Bill Harper pops into the chat from Hobo Jones & The Junkyard Dogs.

Scott has a busy show tonight with a lot to think about, so he doesn’t want to drink too much or thinks he might “bollocks it up”.

He makes it clear he loves pubs and can’t wait to get back in them...but only ones that are safe and adhering to social distancing measures.

Tom from The Lottery Winners mentioned earlier in the week that whenever there’s a world catastrophe, musicians always step up to help out in some way...which is why it seems so unfair the government is doing nothing to help them during the Covid-19 crisis.

Scott signs off: “Have fun you crazy kids. Ta-raaaa””

Fan Matthew Jarvis said he went to A&E after having a 'zipper moment'. Scott says: "there's nothing worse than tender plums."

Amanda reminds Scott to explain that Leap Of Faith isn't going to be a Dark Side Of The Tarn re-record...it will be its own thing.

Lots of shout outs follow.

Paula Makepeace had been worried about returning to work in a pub earlier in the week and Scott is blown away by the support Doonifans offered her.

Scott plays Billy Don't Be A Hero by Paper Lace, a song that was considered by the NME to be the worst number one of the 70s.

Simon Nichols (not the one from Fairport Convention) challenges Scott to perform the very wordy It's The End Of The World As We Know It by REM. Scott accepts the challenge...nails it.

Jo Pollard's dog Alfie is making quite the impression on the cuteness scale...Scott and Amanda are loving him.

Next up, the raucous Tribute by Tenacious D.

Someone compares Gloria to Anita from Bargain Hunt. Amanda thinks she's channelling a bit of Lorraine Kelly.

Scott swoons after his wish came true to do a Dickie Bird duet with the beautifully voiced folk singer, Kathryn Roberts. She performed it in her rather messy garage...with Doonifans nicknaming her 'Messy Garage Lady' as a result.

Final aftershow song is The Wildhearts' 29 Times The Pain.

Amanda closes with some kind words towards fans for their support and says: "If you've gone along with daftness, then that's brilliant."
