Preceding it is another Pre-show Nerves, dated 16/05/2020, titled PRE-SHOW NERVES #8. In fact this is just a 3 second clip as Scott seemed to be experiencing some technical difficulties.

A jaunty track by Cockney duo Chas & Dave sounds out from the turntable this evening.  
"Chas & Dave's always a good way of warming up a night," says Scott.

Adding to the merriment, Scott is bedecked in a cheerful rose-pink shirt under a pastel rimmed tank top with pale irregular stripes of sky blue, lime green, lemon, orangey-red, and a dark bluey stripe running across chest line. Richard Ayoade and Dennis the Menace on badges.

Once again, Amanda is knitting downstairs. She's getting very close to completing the first half of Scott's new rainbow tank top.

Scott: "There's been far too much misery in this world this week. So, er...so I'm gonna make damn sure that we have a bloody good time."

Lindsey Smith messages to say it's Eurovision night (Scott smiles, shakes head).

"Oh, the one thing you're not gonna get from me tonight, Lindsey, is any Eurovision songs. I do for Eurovision what Harold Shipman did for the NHS."

Viewers are told to expect some old stuff, some new stuff, some singalongs...and plenty of drinking!

Alan and Bjorn have told Scott he can't play Chas & Dave before shows any more as he's played them to death. "Seeing as they're...they're not here at the minute, I can get away with it," he laughs.

Scott's tried to get a new router working in the van for the aftershow. He's hoping for an improved signal.
