The first song is Frank Turner’s Photosynthesis. Scott dedicates it to Morris & Watson, tonight’s main show guests.

Scott and Amanda received a package earlier in the week from Sara Grattan who lives in Looe. “It’s always nice to have a lovely package,” says Scott. “I wouldn’t know,” retorts Amanda. The package contained Cornish pasties, scones and clotted cream. Apparently, Scott wolfed a pasty the second the box was opened.
