Viewing figures were up tonight – Scott thinks it's because everyone is "back indoors".

£1800 has been raised by around 200 fans for Barnsley Hospital. Scott and Amanda wanted to do this as a thank you to staff for looking after Amanda's mum while she was poorly. Sadly, she passed away earlier this week.

Despite everything, Scott and Amanda are trying to remain upbeat.

Scott turns the camera round to show everyone Amanda's "happy socks". They're electric blue with lots of small bright yellow bananas.

Gary Wells, a good friend of Scott's, taught him the first song of the night. It's The Day I Saw Bo Didley In Washington Square by American singer-songwriter Willie Nile. Scott is dedicating it to the Doonicans' US fans. He's feeling hopeful after Joe Biden was elected president of the United States today.

Staying with an American theme, Scott plays The Proclaimers' Letter From America.

The Beatles' Girl is up next.

135 people are still watching at around 29 minutes into the aftershow, breaking a campervan record.

Then, Doris Day's Dream A Little Dream Of Me. At the end Scott lifts his glass of beer, holds it aloft, says: "That one was for Amanda's mum."

Final song: Thank You For The Music by ABBA.
