General:

Scott has a spot of Danish gothic-folk on his record player tonight – Myrkur (meaning 'darkness' in Icelandic). The band started life as a death metal outfit, but later dabbled in a combination of genres. "My kid brother bought me that one...it's raight good."

Scott sits himself down and has a swig of beer. Looking somewhat contemplative, he quips: "It's a bit Eurovisiontastic, this album. Great album...but, it's a bit Eurotastic."

He then goes on to explain about tonight's main show, which has a slightly different format to the normal Big Neet Ins. It's Big Neet In/Out Part 1 – mostly featuring video footage of the first Big Neet Out live show, post lockdown.

“Tonight is a show that we did in 2021. It’s our Big Neet Out show, so after all of the lockdown and all of the mayhem that was lockdown, we decided in our infinite wisdom that we were going to build a big puppet tent, like a Punch & Judy tent, with a bit of help from my little sister, who stitched it all together. And I got a load of plastic piping, and then Amanda and meself sat and wrote, what in essence became a three hour show, that we could do live. And we did it for one night only at The Lantern Theatre in Sheffield, in front of a sold out audience, er...which was MAD! The idea of doing that after all the months of sitting in this very room and entertaining people that we couldn’t see, it seemed very strange to suddenly be in front of people that we could see. I say that **we** could see (giggles), Amanda couldn’t see then ‘cuz she was inside a tent.”

This is the first time Big Neet Out will be available for all to view – previously, only those who purchased the album have seen it.

“It was quite a monumental moment, coming out of lockdown, knowing that we were gonna do a live version of what we’d been doing all the way through the pandemic.”

Tomorrow night, Scott plans to show Big Neet Out 2, which took place in 2022 at the same venue.

“We’re gonna be back at the Lantern Theatre later this year for the third, and probably the final one – we don’t know if we’ll do a fourth one...er, cuz we don’t know if we’ve got enough steam in us to actually do that kind of thing.”

He mentions tonight’s aftershow, saying: “I’ve deliberately picked happy songs, because the world needs a bit o’ happiness, dun’t it?”

Ends: “We’ll see you on the flip side. Have fun you crazy kids. Ta-ra!”
