Emu is mentioned in "The Ornithologist Waltz" as Amanda is menacing Scott with him during the performance.

The orange puppet has drawn in eyebrows in "Paint 'Em Back".

When playing the Tea Tent at the Bearded Theory that the Bar-Stewards hadn't been booked for Scott asked Gail Something-Else to bill them as That Bastard Van Morrison but instead she billed

them as Clem Fandango & The Sex Symbols in tribute to the character in the TV series "Toast Of London".

2014 Bearded Theory was the first appearance of the crowd surfing lilo 2016 the dingy made its debut.

Video opens to reveal a shiny black record spinning on a turntable. Californian new wave band, The Go-Go's, sing out.

Scott's looking tank-top-tastic in a pinky-orange and lemon striped number with mint edging, over a rose-pink shirt. Badges are 'Go Folk Yourself' and Dennis the Menace.

Tonight's show is expected to be a choppy one, with lots of things to fit in, lots of buttons to press.

"As long as I don't get too drunk, we should be alright," says Scott.

Scott's moved his wireless router again, so it's near to the window that's next to where the van is. He's hoping this will resolve the aftershow connectivity issues.

Scott mentions that Muddy Summers & The Dirty Field Whores are playing at 11pm and that viewers will have plenty of time to tune in and see them, following the BNI aftershow.

He also says tonight's BNI is a Bearded Theory special and, in tribute, encourages people to send in photos of their beards.

Scott requests a moment of silence for a fan called Barry, whose Xbox died after BNI #6.

Amanda has commenced the second side of Scott's new tank top.

Scott turns The Go-Go's up, says bye.

The broadcast opens with Scott towering over the camera, a bright orange woollen beard dangling from his chin.

Signal seems to be better this evening. A wire can be seen trailing in through the campervan's sunroof.

Scott's drinking Proper Job.

Amanda does a massive sneeze.

A birthday roll call of about 60 people is read out.

Bjorn is growing a beard.

Scott reckons Bjorn is the only Doonican who could pull off a beard, due to his Viking blood.

Scott plays The Waterboys' Fisherman's Blues for Alan, as Alan really likes the song. Amanda holds 'knitted Alan in a jar' up to camera as it begins.

Scott holds up a sheet of A4 paper and asks viewers to go to Twitter and follow @MsSarahGatford. (She does sign language on the Doonicans' The Zipper)

Next up, he asks people to video themselves singing Pulp's Common People and post footage to the Facebook thread.

Earlier in the day, Scott and Amanda found a seemingly abandoned police car parked diagonally across their driveway. "In the end, I actually rang South Yorkshire police, just to check that it had not been nicked," says Scott. It was there for two hours before officers eventually returned.

They're not sure what to do for next week's show and need to have a think.

"I think next week's striptease week, with...er...with, with, me...er, me and the puppets," quips Scott. (He laughs)

Scott: "God bless, goodnight. You lovely, lovely buggers. You're awesome!"
