Chas & Dave’s Rockney is up on the turntable tonight as this special Hootenanny pre-show opens.

“Evenin’ everybody! Hope you’re all alreight,” says a cheery Scott.

Turning the camera on himself, we can see he's sporting a snazzy purple shirt under the rainbow tank-top Amanda knitted for him during the pandemic. Badges being worn are a black 'Go Folk Yourself' one with white lettering and a white badge, imitating Frank Turner's black cross logo, with the letters S, D, H, C (Scott Doonican Hardcore).

Scott sounds a little out of breath and he tells us he's just walked upstairs, which, since his recent bout of Omicron is proving more difficult than usual.

Nonetheless, he promises a 'hell of a night'.

"I'm hoping you're all looking forward to kicking 2021 up the arse and into, er, into 2022, into the long grass."

Scott holds up a signed copy of Chas & Dave's single Mustn't Grumble and says he's a huge fan of theirs. He notes that they, along with The Worzels, were one of the first acts to get away with singing in their own accent, rather than trying to sound American. He thinks they helped pave the way for the Doonicans to sing in their own fine Barnsley tongue.

Scott and the Doonicans did 60 shows between them this year, despite the ongoing prevalence of Covid. Twenty-two of those were festivals and other gigs with Alan and Bjorn, which Scott describes as 'great fun', the rest were Big Neets In.

It's already way past midnight.

Scott has another Chas & Dave album ready for him and Amanda to listen to after the aftershow...though she is less than impressed with this. Apparently, pre-pandemic, when the band were packing up after a gig, he'd play Chas & Dave so much that Amanda, Alan and Bjorn became, in Amanda's words, 'over chas'ed'.

Scott and Amanda are both really tired.

There are 87 viewers around 3 minutes in.

Scott says he bought Bjorn a Paul McCartney anthology for Christmas, as Bjorn is starting to like Macca more and more.

In honour of this, Scott sings Paul McCartney's Everybody's Gonna Dance Tonight.

"Merry New Year you lot!" says Scott, before having a sip of Guinness.

All the bands for the first Big Day Out in October 2022 have now been announced. Scott says he's tried to make it a real 'mixed bag' of musical acts.

He is planning to take January 'off' to try and write a new album, though another BNI is planned for Burns Night on January 25<sup>th</sup>.

Scott reveals that when Amanda works Wallace the yeti puppet's mouth, she moves her own mouth too. He has a good giggle at this.

The pair sign out wishing everyone health and happiness for the New Year.
