The title page image has been changed to include fireworks and a picture of Barnsley Town Hall as well as an image of Scott wearing a party hat which reads “Happy New Year!”

Gloria has been given a promotion and will be running the video jukebox and dedications.

Winnona was sent to Scott & Amanda by Wino from Hobo Jones & The Junkyard Dogs they named her after him.

Sooty wears the cardboard beard from the Bearded special during “When I’m Sixty Four”.

In “MasterMorris” Gervais’ full name is given as Gervais Le Coiffeur. Gervais scores 0 in his specialist subject round on Geoff Hurst in the 1966 World Cup although this isn’t screened. BNI regular viewer Lynn Chitty is said to have scored 1 point on “Curtains of the rich and famous” While Gemma Collins has scored 6 and Joey Essex 7. Gervais manages to win by answering “Hello” to all questions except the final question where he correctly answers “Hello Goodbye” in regards to a Beatles question.

Percy was sent in by Catherine & Dave to help out around the house.

Percy holds the kazoo for Scott in “The Cockwombling Song” and when Amanda’s sleeve is seen on camera Percy bites her arm and pulls it back to display just the sock covered portion!

A countdown clock is displayed on a tablet throughout “Pint Fever” ready for midnight and the New Year!

The banner during “Jump Ararnd” changes to read “Happy New Year To Doonifans Everywhere” and during “Rainbow Connection” changes to read “Thank You For Bringing In 2021 With Us – Lots of love – Scott, Amanda and the big Neet In Posse – See you for the aftershow”

Tis HOOttenaanNNNNy! toneet.

But wait...things are mighty quiet. Nothing is stirring...not even a mouse.

No music.

Just a red-shirted, un-tank-topped Scott.

“It’s a little bit quieter than normal. Er, two reasons for that...first of all...er...last week, err, Facebook, er...took our video...errrrr, well thee took the sound out on it because, er, cuz I played something that, that, clearly, was er...copyrighted and, and, obviously too too big fer er fer Facebook to allow me to let me keep it on. So what I’ve decided is, I’m gonna put the song on at the end of the video, and then if thee tek it down, erm, then it’ll not be tekken out before er, before I get chance ter talk ter y’all, so that’ll be good.”

Allison Edwards’ children Zach and Jasmine have spent time colouring in Jon Shanks’ sketches, which he’s posted to the Doonie group for people to colour in. Scott praises the kids’ efforts.

Morris’ quiz takes longer to film than it does for Scott and Amanda to do the main BNI shows!

Scott’s quite nervous as there’s a lot that could go wrong tonight.

Sadly, Scott and Amanda’s friend Clive lost his battle with motor neurone disease a few days ago.

“He was the epitome of one of the good guys,” says Scott.

“In true Big Neet In fashion, we’re gonna keep it light tonight, we’re gonna plough on, er, and we’re gonna dance like nobody’s watchin’ and we’re gonna have a lovely night, all of us. Erm, there’s bin a lotta loss in 2020 fer a lotta people, er, ourselves included. Aaannd, we’re, we’re gonna see this year out...well and truly OUT. Er, Yer know, I’d quite happily kick it out the door, er, yer know, to make sure that it’s gone...er, and I’m sure there’s plenty of you that feel the same way.”

75 people are watching at around 04:20.

Scott’s reveals he’s had a couple of beers already. Cheers!

And now he braves the Facebook police, pops on some music.

It’s The Who, 1921.

First lines:

I’ve got a feeling twenty-one
Is going to be a good year

Especially if you and me
See it in together

And on those poignant lyrics, this mid-pandemic New Years' Eve pre-show draws to a close.

The Hootenannigans continue in The Pint & Puppet...first time in this space for an aftershow!

Scott's aptly dressed in a red tartan waistcoat over a red shirt, paired with matching trousers.

As Amanda puts the puppets to bed, he pans around the pub and it's all looking positively festive with tinselled picture frames and a faux log burner on full flame.

Over 300 people were clocked watching the main show at one point.

First song: Happy Hour by The Housemartins.

The second song is dedicated to Amanda's mum and Clive Lane, both of whom passed away recently. It's Dream A Little Dream Of Me by Mama Cass of The Mamas & The Papas. Amanda zooms the camera in on a picture of her mum x x.

Scott's mum pops in on the chat. She mentions how his Aunt Nita loves to sing Dream A Little Dream Of Me, but absolutely kills it. Scott quips: "Me Aunt Nita does for singing what Matt Hancock's done for the NHS."

Third song: Chas & Dave's There Ain't No Pleasing You.

Scott says he and Amanda got their green fleur-de-Lys Pint & Puppet carpet for a bargain at £180. "Wilton carpet, this! It's lovely. It's like tufted Wilton...it's bang-on!"

Next up, Scott rings the pub's bell to announce the Shit Raffle winners.

Fourth and final song: ABBA's Thank You For The Music.

Matt Savage from The Levellers pops up on the thread.

Scott and Amanda sit next to each other for closing chat.

Thank yous and goodbyes.
