#### **General:**

“So, pre-show...what can I say? It’s gonna be quite the night...we’ve got all sorts planned,” says Scott, referring to tonight’s special Big Neet In fundraiser in aid of his brother Matt who was recently diagnosed with Synovial Sarcoma.

Matt’s illness is a rare and very aggressive form of cancer which began in his foot and later resulted in his leg having to be amputated. It was subsequently thought that everything was ok, but sadly his cancer came back.

“He’s got twelve tumours in his lungs. They’ve said it’s inoperable,” Scott says.

Money raised tonight will go towards helping Matt to make memories with his family in the time he has left and to support them in the future.

“It’s awful to think that he’s going through this...and I hate the fact that he is. And I think anybody that’s in our position would be feeling exactly the same,” says a stoic Scott.

However, he assures everyone that the show will be upbeat. “We owe it to Matt to make sure it’s really fun. It’s going to be anarchic. It’s going to be everything that should be feelgood about Big Neet In. Erm...those of you that have followed us throughout the pandemic know how much...er... it’s always meant to me to make sure that we keep it light and...erm...you know...to, to address the fact that, you know...sometimes it’s ok not to be ok.”

Scott encourages viewers to share the fundraising link and to either give if they can afford to or simply leave a message for Matt. He acknowledges that ‘times are hard’ and ‘everyone’s on their arse at the minute’.

We are told Matt might watch the show but he’s been very poorly this week with neutropenic sepsis (the second time it’s happened), where he’s ended up in hospital hooked up to an IV. “Cancer’s an absolute twat,” says Scott, shaking his head.

“God bless the chuffing lot of you before we even start...er...and have a lovely night where you are. Take it easy. Love you all.”

N.B. Scott’s tank top tonight is his older ‘trademark’ one with rainbow colours, over a cosmic patterned purple shirt with eyeballs. Badges: Dennis the Menace and Richard Ayoade.

We arrive to an ambient pink lit Pint & Puppet (that’s a lot of Ps).

Again, it’s been a while since the last BNI and another discussion takes place as to where each puppet goes (they all have their designated spots in the pub).

Scott: “Thank you so, so much to everybody that donated tonight.”

(Matt’s fundraising total is currently around the £25,000 mark)

Scott says viewing figures for the main show hit ‘pandemic levels’ (so around 130). “It has been quite the rollercoaster. There’s been bits of the show where I’ve just thought, right, just soldier on, just do the show, and other parts where I’ve been in bits in between and I had to mop me eyes and get mesen ready fer the next bit. You guys have been absolutely f\*\*kin’ incredible. Um, pardon my French...pamplemousse.”

Amanda: "Sarah's song were...sorry, Marla's...absolutely beautiful." Scott laughs as Amanda slips up and says his sister's real name, Sarah, instead of her more commonly used nickname. He says 'Marla' came about around the time of the film Fight Club and it just stuck. "Our Lewy jokingly said that she looked a bit like Marla Singer in Fight Club, in the fact that her eyeliner was always smudged."

Marla wrote 'Unyielding Flame' as a tribute to Matt, and Scott and Lewy performed it with her on tonight's BNI. It is the first time the trio have played together in eighteen years. Back then, all four siblings were in a band called Läskiämpäri (which I have to say I'm not thanking them for as it's just taken me ages to figure out how to get an umlaut on my laptop!) The name means 'Fatbucket' in Finnish.

Fun fact 1: Matt played all the drums in 'Moustache Not Included'.

Fun fact 2: Kermit appeared in the main show thanks to Dave Alvarez, a Disney storyboard artist, who Scott managed to get in touch with via a Muppets group.

Scott says he jokingly sent a message to Matt while the quiz was on to say, "it took 17 years, but I finally got the whole family to come to a show."

The camera zooms in on 'Morris Minor', an orange finger puppet with three googly eyes, made by Lynn Chitty. It is placed on top of a miniature bottle of Guinness given to Scott by his dad.

Scott pours himself a glass of eight-year-old malt, Amanda grabs a gin, and they make a toast. "To our Matt!...to Claire, to Ez and to all of you out there. F\*\*k cancer, it's shit. Love you guys."

He then prepares for a song. Before singing it he talks some more about Matt, this time about his sense of humour. "He will find funny in dark things sometimes and I love that about him.

Erm...Matt...don't ever f\*\*king change. This is for you mate." It's Doris Day's Dream A Little Dream Of Me.

"Matt, I hope we did you proud. And to you lot, thank you so much," says Scott as he starts to wrap things up.

Before going he regales the following story...

"Lewy was once sick out of a bunk bed on top of our Matt..."

Amanda: "This is lovely."

"...I'm oversharing, I know," Scott continues. "I can still remember me mum more or less diggin' all't carrots out of his ears. Bless him. It was like, about two in the morning. Oh, it was the most awful thing to see..."

Amanda: "I bet you were upset."

"...To be honest, at the time I thought it was hilarious. I was probably about 10, 11 at the time. I was proper laughing because he was covered in sick. But...sorry mate..."

Amanda: "You wouldn't have been laughing if you'd have been covered in sick."

(Delightful)

Scott ends: "Stay awesome. Don't do anything stupid. And don't do anything we wouldn't do...so it narrows it down to heroin."

Both grin cheekily as the camera fades.
