

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #1 The Bar-Steward Sons of Val Doonican played their first show at Thawleys pub in Wombwell, Barnsley on 17th June 2006. Their intention was to play a 'one-off' show at the Barley Mow in Bonsall, Derbyshire, but they did a warm-up show at Scott's local pub. The planned Barley Mow show followed a week later, and the line-up expanded to a threesome (not in the Biblical sense!). The ensuing 3-piece line-up is considered to be the original Mk.1 line-up of the band.

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #2 26TH SEPT 2009-The addition of Alan Doonican #1 on accordion was exclusive to shows

performed at his pub, the Barley Mow, Bonsall, Derbyshire, until he sold the pub and joined the band as a full-timer on 20th Sept 2009. THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #3 17TH MARCH 2011-

Danny left the band on 17th March 2011, after playing his 98th show at The Beggar & Gentleman in Hoyland, Barnsley. Scott & Alan #1 continued as a duo, whilst looking for Danny's replacement. This was the last show with the bands original Mk.1 line-up.

THE BAR—STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #4 8TH APRIL 2011-

Former Barnum & Bailey Circus lion-tamer, Andy Doonican, joined as second guitarist on 8th April 2011, taking over additional instrument duties on tenor banjo and bouzouki... both tuned to guitar tuning. This was to ensure that Alan #1, who believed the band didn't need another quitarist, thought that Andy was a talented multi-instrumentalist. Alan never found out. This became the band's Mk.ll line-up. THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #5

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #6 IST MAY 2011

Danny Doonican returned for one final duo show on 1st May 2011 in the early hours for the Wath Folk Festival after-show party.

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #9 Line-ups #7-9 all took place over two days, in the period that Scott refers to as The Lost Weekend. In Andy Doonican's absence, three new

Bjorn Doonicansson, who joined to cover Andy Doonican, in his increasing absence from live shows. He became a full-timer, not too long afterwards and stayed with the band until 2023. THE BAR—STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #10 16711 MAY 2014-With Bjorn joining as a full-time member, a now expanded 4-piece line-up played their first show together at the Butcher's Arms, Swinton, Rotherham on 16th May 2014. After the show, Andy announced that he was going to become a dad, later in the year. This line-up worked flexibly as a quo, trio and quartet, depending on who was available to play. Andy started to appear more sporadically, and more often than not, the trio of Scott, Alan #1 and Bjorn were the core part of the band from April to October 2014.

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #11 315T MAY 2014 At a show at the Acoustic Festival of Britain on 31st May 2014, when Andy Doonican no-showed, a quickly conscripted Foxy Doonican came to the rescue, learning the set in less than an hour, and joined the band for the evening. He later appeared for a few one-off shows during another infamously ill-fated UK tour with The Lancashire Hotpots.

THE BAR—STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #12 11TH OCT 2014 Line-ups #11 to # Π were the result of a series of unfortunate events, that began as the band commenced a UK tour supporting fellow northern comedy band. The Lancashire Hotpots. Mere days before the tour began, Scott's partner Amanda, was diagnosed with breast cancer, but to make matters worse, on the first night of the tour, Alan #1 quit the band, leaving Scott to have to try and ensure some sort of band was available to play the dates. The line-up wasn't the same for most nights of the tour. This included the only date that Scott hasn't performed with the band, when Bjorn was forced to take lead vocal duties at Nottingham Rescue Rooms. The tour saw the addition of Alan #2 as Alan #1's permanent replacement, but due to previous commitments, he was unable to play all of the shows on the tour.

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #12 18TH OCT 2014

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #13 25TH OCT 2014

The first appearance of what eventually became the Mk. III line-up of the band, was at Scarefest at Harefield Hall, Pately Bridge on 25th Oct 2014. Alan #2 was auditioned in front of a live audience and passed with flying colours.

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #14 151 NOV 2014-

This four-piece line-up first appeared on stage together at the Ol Academy in Sheffield. The core band of Scott, Bjorn & Alan continued to do most shows, whilst Andy's increasingly rare appearances continued. Andy finally retired after the band's 10th birthday show, a year and a half later. THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #15 811h NOV 2014-

Skiffle tastic cousin Bobby joined on tea chest bass for some of the dates on the tour, and later joined the band again on future dates but only as a

part time honorary member. THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #16 15TH NOV 2014

Cousin Bobby joined Scott and Bjorn for another of the tour shows, this time at the King George's Hall, Blackburn, Lancashire. THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #17

After another no show from Andy Doonican, brother Foxy returned for a show at Mexborough Imperial Club.

After the Hotpots tour, the four piece line-up of Scott, Bjorn, Alan #2 & Andy returned on 18th April 2015, after a several month hiatus, whilst Amanda successfully battled cancer. During this downtime, the band wrote the songs that become The Tarn Machine, released in May 2015. This line-up continued to function primarily as a three-piece, with Andy playing shows when he could. THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #18 25TH MAR 2015

For Scott's 36th birthday, the band supported The Blockheads at Holmfirth Picturedrome. For this special occasion, Bobby returned, giving the band its

first five piece line up for one night only. THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #19 21ST MAY 2015

For the band's appearance at Bearded Theory festival in Derbyshire, a long-lost sister, Sdrah Doonican was discovered. Scott was keen to make the band's show more inclusive, and so Sarah joined the band as a part time member, sign interpreting the show into British Sign Language for deaf festival goers. Sarah has returned for other shows with the band on

several occasions as an honorary member. THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #20 1714 JUNE 2016-

After the band's 10th birthday show, Andy retired in order to spend more time with his family. The core of the band continued as a much settled trio, for the following seven years.

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #21 As the band played to their biggest audience to date at Fairport's Cropredy Convention (20,000 people) they were joined by Maart Doonican who was made an honorary member for the day. Maart sadly passed away 36 days later after a short battle with liver cancer.

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #22 18TH AUG 2019

The band expanded to a quartet again for their appearance at Beautiful Days festival 2019, with the addition of bassist Mojo Doonican, from Coolville, Ohio. Mojo became an occasional honorary member, making further appearances after this date. THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #23 22ND AUG 2021

For their appearance at Beautiful Days festival 2021, along with bassist Mojo Doonican, drummer Keith Moonican also became an occasional honorary member, making further appearances after this date. THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #24 215T OCT 2023

Technically, this expanded line-up of the band performed at Beautiful Days festival in 2022 and 2023, as well as the first Big Day Out Festival in 2022, but it was only when they played at the Big Day Out v2.0 Festival in Oct 2023 that the rhythm section of drummer Dalgas Doonican from Sao Paulo in Brazil and the mysterious and wizard-like Mushroom Doonican, chose to perform with Doonican monikers for the first time.

THE BAR-STEWARD SONS OF VAL DOONICAN #25 PRESENT 2024-When Bjorn Doonicansson announced he was leaving the band at the end of the 2023 Winter Woollies Tour, this signalled the end of the band's Mk. III line-up. A flexible quintet Mk. IV line-up made its first official appearance after it was revealed to the public on stage at the Rescue Rooms, Nottingham.
