Amanda hoists in a Marvin The Martian plush toy followed by his dog "K-9" during "Starman".

"Monk On" is explained as being slang for being in a strop.

Morris wants a badge as Gordon, Gloria and Percy have been given them. Scott gives him a Morris NASA Space badge as he's an alien (Don'tcha know).

Scott calls his Steel Dobro his Barnsley Fightin' Guitar!

The limited "Big Neet In – Pint & Puppet" T-Shirt design is shown.

Canadians From Space do their interview with Gloria from space, their location given on screen is Space Complex Alpha & Space Complex Bravo.

Amanda causes Scott to have to stop singing during "The Lady In Greggs" as he is laughing too much at the appearance of a large Swedish flag.

The banner text during "The Road" reads "Thanks for tuning in, we'll see you for the big #50 – Love Scott, Amanda & Co.

There's a short clip of Barnsley Bob Ross after the final Test Card at the end of the show.

Scott's Tank Top Badges : No Tank Top tonight, Scott is in an Astronaut outfit to go with the space theme of the show.

General:

An unusual tank top tonight – looks like one that's been bought rather than hand knitted. It has an orange neckline and arm holes, with green and red in a busy Aztec-like pattern. Worn over a black T-shirt. No badges.

It's red hot in Scott's music room, even though no radiators are on. It's at the top of his house and the heat just rises up. He says it would 'kill' his guitars if he put the heating on in that room. So he never does.

He says he's got to rush off and change as tonight's show has a space theme...hence the intro song being Prodigy's Out Of Space.

And with that he takes a break to another dimension...pay close attention.

General:

Tonight's aftershow opens with a rather out of breath Scott in a bright orange space suit.

"Yer huffin an puffin," says Amanda.

"I am. I'm knackered. I'll tell yer what, I've realised over this lockdown...I'm not fit," replies Scott.

90 people are tuned in at around 01:45.

Scott had a bit of a "plectrum panic" when he got down to The Pint & Puppet as he'd lost the one he'd been using for the main show. Luckily he carries spares in his wallet and got another one from there.

Scott unzips his space suit to cool off, revealing the orange edged tank top from the pre-show. Amanda starts to pull it down off his shoulders.

Scott: "Actually, no don't cuz me pants'll fall down."

Amanda: "Oh God!"

After a bit of a fiddle, she manages to tie the suit at waist level. At last Scott can breathe again :)

He gives a big shout out and thank you to tonight's guests, Canadians In Space.

First song: I Am An Astronaut by Ricky Wilde.

Scott thanks Andrea Wright and Paula McArdle as they started a Twitter campaign to try and get the Doonicans a shout out on Channel 4's The Last Leg for their Lockdown Awards. The plan didn't work, however loads of Doonifans posted lovely tweets and Scott and Amanda saw all of them and were blown away by the support.

Second song: Suckerpunch by The Wildhearts.

T-shirt pre-orders end tomorrow night at midnight (Pint & Puppet ones I think).

Song number three is Chas & Dave's Ain't No Pleasing You.

Then on to a Tom Waits number which Scott dedicates to Amanda. He switches some mood lighting on, saying he can't play it in bright light. It's I Hope That I Don't Fall In Love With You.

Scott mentions Ricky and Ralf's Very Northern Road Trip as being a show he likes (Ricky Tomlinson and Ralf Little). This leads to a brief mention of The Royle Family and a fan who caused a bit of a nuisance of herself, heckling at one of his solo shows in Liverpool. He finished that night covering Oasis' Half The World Away, more famously known as the theme tune to The Royle Family, and says things were calmer after that. He plays it again now.

Final song of the night: Closer To Fine by Indigo Girls.

Scott goes and sits next to Amanda. Clues are given for next week's guest. There's a close up of Simon from Simon and Garfunkel and one of a Levellers' album. Amanda says "Tell yer friend." Scott agrees: "Tell yer friend...friends."
