Scott’s keeping this brief as he needs to go and tune his guitar.

The aftershow opens with Scott scrolling his iPad screen, his finger appearing very large to viewers :)

Clues for next week’s show are sounds, like alarm and siren.

Scott’s wondering if BNI viewing figures will go down next week as it’s looking like pub beer gardens will be open then. He thinks there’ll be a mad rush even though the weather is still freezing.

He and Amanda have a chuckle about Trotsky’s recent storytelling live stream where he mimicked and mashed up some well known BNI puppet lines, creating a gem all of his own. Through his character Mo, based on Amanda’s Morris, Trotsky was growling in a cockney accent, lines like “D’you

like apples?" and "Look at your brains". Scott says he was "basically channelling the best Ray Winstone I've ever heard".

Random fact: Scott never liked Bruce Springsteen until he heard The Seeger Sessions.

On that note, he rolls into Bruce's Waitin' On A Sunny Day.

Amanda turns The Pint & Puppet fire off as she and Scott are 'melting'.

Next up, a drinking song that Scott and Danny used to perform in the early days. It's Bruce's Philosophers Song, also known as The Bruces' Song, by Monty Python.

Scott searches for Amanda's glasses in her bag as she was struggling to reach them herself, being on camera duty an' all.

A melancholic number follows, it's Cousin Jack by Show Of Hands.

After a request from a fan, Scott agrees to do a most inappropriate song...it's Stephen Lynch's Gerbil. It's also totally brilliant. At the part where it says 'I almost had him with a pair of plyers,' Amanda makes a scissor snipping motion with her fingers in front of the camera.

"Have we got anybody still watching?" Scott says at the end :)

Moving on, it's Eagles' Desperado.

Big thanks to Lil' Jim, tonight's special guest.

Final song is Van Halen's Jump.

Scott moves across to sit with Amanda. He says next week's show will have a Western theme and hints there may be a new puppet for the occasion.
