General:

Scott fiddles with a huge tuft on his wig silky smooth totally real hair.

Aftershow viewing figures are lower tonight as many people have jumped ship to catch Paul McCartney's live Glastonbury set on the Beeb. But Doonifans on the video chat are saying how much they loved the puppet chorus singing Hey Jude at the end of the main Big Neet In show. Scott says it took about two days to put together.

There are 47 viewers around 2 minutes in.

Scott kicks off with an early Beatles' track – Things We Said Today.

Eliza Carthy has a new album coming out soon, celebrating her 30 years in the music industry. She's doing a video for this and has asked Scott if he can create some footage with the puppets, to be included in it.

Scott and Amanda reminisce about the time they were at a very hot and sticky Glastonbury (the year the Doonicans first played there) and saw Kylie, The Proclaimers and Björn Again.

Next up it's ABBA's Knowing Me, Knowing You.....aHAAAAA!

One of Scott's favourite Glastonbury headliners (when he watched on TV) was Beyoncé.....or Boy-onss, as Amanda's dad called her. Crazy In Love follows. It's dedicated to a couple of Doonifans, Stuart and Lynne, who got married today.

Suzanne Vega is scheduled to play at this years' Underneath The Stars in Barnsley, which Scott and Amanda are very excited about. Luka is played as a nod to this.

The final song is one Scott and Danny first did in the early days of the Doonicans. It's Sparks' This Town Ain't Big Enough For The Both Of Us.

A short discussion follows about upcoming gigs, including a headliner slot at Fuse festival in Lichfield, before Scott and Amanda head off to watch Macca on iPlayer.

The next Big Neet In will be on the 1st October 2022.
