Aftershow #50 opens with Amanda puppet wrangling...otherwise known as putting them back in their ‘beds’ in The Pint & Puppet until next week’s show. As she sets Gervaise in position, a

dartboard can be seen just above his head. Scott admits that when he and Amanda have a game they move the puppets “because we have got feelings, all of us”.

Scott mentions again that he likes round numbers. He checks to see how many viewers are watching. There are 106 (at around 03:25). He cocks his head, admits he was happier when there was 100 : )

Amanda takes the camera, zooms in on the pub’s curtains for Doonifan and curtain connoisseur Lynn Chitty, while Scott gets ready for a song.

Adam Myers from Canadians In Space is watching.

Scott says when he did a YouTube upload test of his and Simon Friend’s Warpigs collaboration he got a notification to say the song is banned in Cuba, Iran, North Korea and Syria. Sadly, this means any Doonifans in these countries will be unable to watch it ; )

And now for some songs. First up is Thin Lizzy’s The Boys Are Back In Town.

The second song is for Simon Friend’s other half, Sadie. It’s Super Trouper by ABBA.

Scott: “To Simon, the Levellers and all that ride with them...cheers!”

Scott is looking troubled. He can’t remember the names of all the Fraggles from Fraggle Rock (clearly he was once a fan). This was prompted by a fan sending in a large card with them on.

Song number three is Cyndi Lauper’s classic tear-jerker Time After Time.

And next up, it’s back to the 70s for a bit of Boney M’s Rasputin. Scott realises it isn’t the easiest song to sing after a few beers...very wordy : )

Then fast forward to the 90s for a spot of The Wonder Stuff, Size Of A Cow.

Scott’s Aunt Sally (not off Worzel Gummidge) pops in on the chat.

Cat Stevens’ Wild World is the final song. Scott says Maartin Alcock was a big Cat fan. Scott drops his pick midway through. He retrieves it from the floor, medleys into I Will Survive, brings the song back to Wild World at the end.

Scott says he’d like to think there could be a Big Neet Out at the end of the year. He asks fans what they think.
