The Levellers’ Just The One is tonight’s main turntable offering and the version being played features Bellowhead. At the time of writing this (July 2021) I can imagine all the Doonifans jiggling round their living rooms, drinks in hand, gearing themselves up for a fun night. Scott later switches to The Men They Could Not Hang’s album, Silver Town.

He’s clad in a pink/lemon tank top with mint edging over a rose pink shirt, with Dennis the Menace and Big Neet In badges pinned to the right hand side.

Scott’s excited about tonight’s guest and the fact that the main show will run a little differently to normal.

It turns out he’s playing They Men They Could Not Hang as a tribute to the band’s co-lead vocalist, Stefan Cush, who passed away today.

Scott thanks everyone who sent in artwork for tonight’s show.

This is the first aftershow from The Pint & Puppet. Scott pans the camera round his home pub as Amanda places the puppets back on their rather phallic looking kitchen roll holders.

136 people are tuned in around 6 minutes in.

First song: Size Of A Cow by The Wonder Stuff.

Scott does a poignant anti-war song next in memory of Stefan Cush. It's Greenfields Of France by Angelic Upstarts.

In an attempt to bring the vibe back up again, Scott steams onward with The Pogues' Sally MacLennane.

He follows this with a love song he wrote for Amanda: I Really Love You Today.

Next, he talks about the importance of people looking after each other and keeping their mental health and spirits high.

Scott thanks Jeremy Cunningham for his art segment, then heads into a rendition of Bob Marley's Three Little Birds. He encourages viewers to film themselves singing along to this and post their clips to the Facebook page.

Raffle winners are called, then Scott goes over to sit by Amanda for closing chat. Amanda smiles and waves as the broadcast ends.
