Scott’s already put a heater in the van for the aftershow as “it’s a bit Baltic out there.”

Goodbyes. Heads over to the main show.

General:

After van hellos, Scott and Amanda both comment how cold it is, despite having set up a heater in there earlier.

At 02:39 minutes in there are 77 viewers.

One fan thinks Scott's Tom Waits' album Orphans is missing from its usual spot. Scott is trying to remember if he's played it recently and maybe moved it (full album title is Orphans – Brawlers, Bawlers and Bastards).

A light blows in the campervan and it's noted that Scott seems to be having a few electrical mishaps at the moment – thinking back to his near fire in the Pint & Puppet the previous week where a plug socket melted.

This week marks five years since David Bowie passed away, so Scott gives viewers a chance to vote for either Starman or Ashes To Ashes. Amanda is tasked with watching the chat thread to see which song proves most popular.

But first, Birdhouse In Your Soul by They Might Be Giants.

Bowie votes are coming in. Starman was in the lead, then fan Simon Nichols started repeat voting for Ashes. Amanda calls him a “cheating hound” :)but his persistence pays off as Scott agrees to cover both tracks.

Scott dedicates Starman to his and Amanda's late friend, Clive Lane.

Moving on, a bit of Beyonce, Crazy In Love...a song Scott and Danny Doonican used to perform back in the early days.

Next up, Dizzy, a Tommy Rowe song covered by numerous artists over the years, including The Wonder Stuff and Vic Reeves.

Scott reveals the Big Neet In theme tune comes from Vic Reeves' I Will Cure You album.

Final song of the evening, Frank Turner's The Road.

Scott heads over to sit next to Amanda.

At around 32 minutes in he notices 100 people are watching. Amanda says there were 110 at one point.

Amanda admits getting hooked on The Masked Singer. Scott denies liking the show, then says he thinks 'the sausage' is Beverley Knight...clearly after having watched a bit :)
