#### General:

Shiver me timbers! As we sail into the Pint & Puppet for the aftershow, Scott is still clad in pirate attire.

"Evenin' all!"

It's been a while and a debate ensues between him and Amanda as to where the puppets should be placed – they all have their own designated spots on the pub's shelves.

Scott's notices his eyeliner has run a bit following 'Rainbow Connection' – the song that closed this evening's main show.

27 people are watching at around 1 minute in.

Scott zooms in on a 'Goonies' album cover on the jukebox and says Morris has been listening to it this week to gear himself up for pirate night in honour of main show guests Jolly Roger.

Regarding his pirate attire, Scott says: "I lost the tash and the beard within the first five minutes of the show because it was ridiculous, and then for the rest of the night the puppets have took the piss saying that I look like Cher."

Amanda: "Shoop shoop."

Scott: "Cheers for that Amanda, you knob!"

Lynn Chitty sent Scott and Amanda a 'Happy Easter' card with a baby Little Morris finger-puppet inside. Amanda sticks it on top of a miniature bottle of Guinness on the bar.

As Scott dons his guitar ready for a song, Amanda quips: "Tonight Matthew, I am Cher."

"Is it too early to tell you to bugger off?" Scott retorts.

Scott rolls his shirt sleeves up, saying it's because he got his buttons caught in his guitar strings earlier.

A couple of fans enquire about Scott's brother Matthew who was recently diagnosed with cancer and had to have his leg amputated. Scott says he couldn't have timed tonight's pirate theme at a worse time. "I don't know if Matt's watching, but Matt, I love you mate." He then goes on to explain that Matt is doing well, is in good spirits, and is now back at home.

The first song is a snippet of The Doors' People Are Strange.

Amanda mentions the song being in The Lost Boys and Scott says they are going to see Kiefer Sutherland in June or July. Amanda also says they've finished the whole of 24, including the extra series. Scott, recognising Amanda's obsession with Kiefer, ponders why she's with him at all, since he looks nothing like Kiefer. Amanda replies: "Oh, he's not my type......(then, laughing)......I'm more of Cher kind of girl."

After a few gig announcements, Scott plays the Cher classic, Just Like Jesse James.

51 people are tuned in at around 24 minutes.

More gig announcements include Scott's Welsh solo debut at the Grand Pavilion in Porthcawl on the 18<sup>th</sup> June, and a full band main stage headliner at Ely Folk Festival on the 7<sup>th</sup> July.

The third song is It's Only Natural by Crowded House.

He mentions the band have been booked for the main stage at Shrewsbury Folk Festival on the 27<sup>th</sup> August and he has bagged a solo slot at the same festival on the 26<sup>th</sup>. The Doonicans have never played this festival before.

Scott has also secured his first solo London gig at The Cavendish in Stockwell on the 8<sup>th</sup> October.

The fourth song is a medley of I Think We're Alone Now, made famous by Tiffany, but originally sung by Tommy James & The Shondells, and The Beach Boys/Ronettes song I Can Hear Music.

More gig announcements include Big Day Out 2 (21st October) and Big Neet Out 3 (28th October).

Scott whips off his pirate wig for song five, Something You Love by Kiefer Sutherland, then he swaps to a uke for the final song of the night, Doris Day's Dream A Little Dream.

Scott ties his hair up in a high ponytail and goes to sit next to Amanda. The pair give a nod to people they know who have sadly passed away in recent days, including Paula Harper Munday, who has been a big follower of the Big Neets In since their inception.

Ends: "God bless and goodnight. See yer later."
