Scott's birthday was on Thursday this week. He and Amanda went for a nice walk at Cannon Hall, a historic house near Barnsley.

He holds up a framed postcard of Sweep that he and his family posted to themselves back in May 1989 while on a day out at The World Of Sooty museum. His mum gave it to him for his birthday this week and it now lives in The Pint & Puppet.

As he gears up to play the first song, Scott wonders if he needs a wee.

He decides to carry on.

Scott thanks this week's main show guest Stevie Simpson.

Fans are loving Bjorn's Folking Around.

Scott starts off with an Elton John song: "D'yer know why? Cuz ee shares same birthdee as me."
It's Saturday Night's Alright.

Buzzcocks' Ever Fallen In Love? is up next.

A gift from Scott's sister Sarah is now opened. Scott looks inside the box, roars with laughter as he sees what's inside. He lifts out a note saying 'Read Me'...

Dear Scott,

You may think you're staring into a strange Funhouse mirror right now, but you're mistaken. My name is Michael. I'm your twin brother, separated shortly after birth, when dad won a custody battle for me. Dad kept me a secret and locked me in the cellar where I lived until six years ago, when I was discovered after dad died. I had a strange upbringing, I didn't learn how to talk until pretty late. In fact, I learned to talk from watching Father Ted in my twenties, when dad let me have a TV. I was only ever allowed to watch that one programme, until much later when I discovered daytime TV. He also gave me a record player, but only gave me a few records from his own collection and The Pogues. I spent most of my days playing an old guitar, listening to The Pogues, eating potatoes, and occasionally the odd spider if I was lucky to find one. Please excuse my behaviour, I never really learned to be sociable, but I did learn how to brew Moonshine. Father Jack and Shane McGowan seemed pretty good as role models. I think my gruff voice is a combination of eating spiders and shouting 'DRINK!' for dad's attention. And living in the cellar seemed to really stunt my growth, as you can probably tell. After living in the cellar, I've been desperately searching for my long-lost relatives. I came across your band and knew you had to be my brother. The resemblance is uncanny. I hope you can see it too, or we're going to have one of those awkward fights like on Jeremy Kyle. I wanted to surprise you, so I found your sister, my half-sister. She's been looking after me. She even made me some clothes as she said she was a fashion designer...whatever that is. I'm not convinced, it's a bit garish, but she said that you would probably like it. She also kitted me out with a guitar and introduced me to Guinness, which is a vast improvement on the Moonshine. And my new favourite food is baked beans. Happy Birthday Scott! I'm a few days late as I got my fingers trapped in a mousetrap when I was looking for a snack. But your sister sorted me out and now I can hold my pint again to celebrate us turning 42. I'd love it if I could come to stay with you. Our sister is lovely, but her kids are driving me crazy. I'm happy to work behind the bar at the pub to earn my keep with Morris, just don't do any stock takes. And I sing a pretty good version of Dirty Old Town and 500 Miles.

Scott lifts Michael out of the box. He's a puppet that looks for all the world like a mini Scott. He's clad in a jazzy tank top, holds a pint of Guinness in his right hand, and his guitar even has the same sticker that Scott has on his real one. He's very impressive. That said, Scott says "he may have to live in the pub, cuz I'm too scared to have him in the house".

Scott clears the packaging away and carries on with some songs. Next up is Pearl Jam, Soon Forget.

A fan points out that Val Doonican's first name is also Michael.

Then, The Beatles' Girl.

Followed by Birdhouse In Your Soul by They Might Be Giants. Scott dedicates this one to his sister Sarah and her husband Jason.

The penultimate song of the night is The Wonder Stuff's Size of A Cow.

And Blackberry Way by The Move tops off the night.
