Bjorn's favourite Doonican's song is “Hi-Ho Mr Traffic Warden” which Scott reveals when talking about the “Dark Side Of The Tarn” album despite it being on ““Ey UP! Let’s Go!”

“Billy Casper and the Budgie From Barnsley” (or similar) was the original idea for ““Ey Up! Let’s Go!” as a Bar-Steward version of “Ziggy Stardust and the Spiders From Mars”.

Andy Doonican was part of an extended Doonican's line up called The Hired Guns

Scott dedicates “Far Far Away” to Chas Hodges of Chas & Dave who are name-checked in the opening lines.

The house phone rings during “Festival Heroes”

Scott cues the backing to “Dead Right Hand” by mistake in “Festival Heroes”.

Emu had drawn in eyebrows during “Bring Me Sunshine”.

The banner text during “Jump ararnd” reads “The Doonican's at Beautiful Days 2018 – Stay Safe And Stay Lovely, Folks”

And an equally groovy tank top (pink-orange stripes, mint edging) over a rose-pink shirt. Badges, Dennis the Menace (and another one that I can’t decipher).

Tonight’s theme is an abridged history of the Doonican's 2006-present.

Amanda’s nearly finished the second side of Scott’s new tank top.

Scott reckons the band’s year is looking pretty much like a write off with regard to gigs.

He was going to play Power In The Darkness by Tom Robinson for Pre-show Nerves but felt The Four Tops was more apt.

Signs off.

Scott: "We're on. Evenin'. Welcome to the aftershow party here in the van."

Scott: "Tonight was a bit of a lairy one wern' it?"

Scott: "I decided tonight fer the aftershow I'd do three songs...er...and I'm gonna pick jolly songs...cuz the world's right miserable at t'minute."

108 people are watching right now.

Scott's going to do a request show next week. If people wish to submit a song they need to send it to the 'Contacts' page on the Doonicans' website.

He's having some tech issues finding the Shit Raffle winners...says he'll post winners' names on the Doonicans' Facebook page later.

Amanda spots Joel on the chat thread.

Scott says: "Ey-up Joel. Ow yer goin' on with the mixin' o that album?" (Amanda laughs at this slightly inebriated bluntness)

He starts playing Birdhouse In Your Soul on ukulele...decides it might sound better on guitar...picks up guitar...realises he hasn't got a capo...goes back to ukulele...says "Shit!" somewhere in amongst all that...causes a gin-infused giggle from Amanda.

Fan Lindsey wants a tour of the van. Amanda pans the camera around, showing broadcast wiring threaded through cupboard door handles, an empty microwave shelf, a kitchen sink...some beer, McCoys cheese and onion crisps and M&S dark chocolate jaffa cakes on a counter... the drivers' seat. Then, she opens a door and a light goes on...the toilet.

Amanda's van tour returns to Scott still trying to locate the Shit Raffle winners. He fails to find them.

They explain how they read the gig thread once the show has ended and are buoyed by it. They enjoy the way fans interact with each other.

Scott: "I think what's really nice about this is, that after the whole covid crisis is over...yer gonna look back at this time n yer gonna realise that...that there were some people that yer've never probly met in yer life that helped yer through this."

Ends, Scott: "Take Care. Goodnight. Erm...it's quarter past 11...so it's late. Go to bed! Or, party into the early hours...whatever you're gonna do. Cheers!"
